The web hosting service provider also provides email services to M.C.C. Kft and deems in both capacity as data processor. The data processor is acting on behalf and at the instructions of the data controller M.C.C Kft. This means that the data processor is not entitled to use personal data for own purposes. The data controller and data processor made a data processing agreement according to Art.28 of GDPR.

##### COOKIES: WWW.RCARE.HU

The web page of M.C.C. Kft minimally collects personal data regarding the visitor of the web page. Such data processing is partly necessary for the proper functioning of the web page, partly to see statistical data regarding the visitors. Such personal data tend to provide statistics regarding the visitors of the web page. The legal basis for data processing for those cookies which are necessary for the proper operation of the web page is the legitimate interest of the data controller. Other cookies may be used only with the prior consent of the visitors. Visitors may check the cookies on their devices anytime and may delete them if they wish.

## D. TERMS IN THIS NOTICE

Please find below the most important terms used by GDPR and applied by RCARE:

**'Personal data'** means any information relating to an identified or identifiable natural person ('data subject'); an identifiable natural person is one who can be identified, directly or indirectly, in particular by reference to an identifier such as a name, an identification number, location data, an online identifier or to one or more factors specific to the physical, physiological, genetic, mental, economic, cultural or social identity of that natural person.

**'Special categories of personal data'** means personal data revealing racial or ethnic origin, political opinions, religious or philosophical beliefs, or trade union membership, and the processing of genetic data, biometric data for the purpose of uniquely identifying a natural person, data concerning health or data concerning a natural person's sex life or sexual orientation.

**'Criminal data'** means personal data relating to criminal convictions and offences or related security measures.

**'Processing'** means any operation or set of operations which is performed on personal data or on sets of personal data, whether or not by automated means, such as collection, recording, organisation, structuring, storage, adaptation or alteration, retrieval, consultation, use, disclosure by transmission, dissemination or otherwise making available, alignment or combination, restriction, erasure or destruction.

**'Restriction of processing'** means the marking of stored personal data with the aim of limiting their processing in the future.

**'Profiling'** means any form of automated processing of personal data consisting of the use of personal data to evaluate certain personal aspects relating to a natural person, in particular to analyse or predict

aspects concerning that natural person's performance at work, economic situation, health, personal preferences, interests, reliability, behaviour, location or movements.

**'Pseudonymisation'** means the processing of personal data in such a manner that the personal data can no longer be attributed to a specific data subject without the use of additional information, provided that such additional information is kept separately and is subject to technical and organisational measures to ensure that the personal data are not attributed to an identified or identifiable natural person.

**'Filing system'** means any structured set of personal data which are accessible according to specific criteria, whether centralised, decentralised or dispersed on a functional or geographical basis.

**'Controller'** means the natural or legal person, public authority, agency or other body which, alone or jointly with others, determines the purposes and means of the processing of personal data; where the purposes and means of such processing are determined by Union or Member State law, the controller or the specific criteria for its nomination may be provided for by Union or Member State law;

**'Processor'** means a natural or legal person, public authority, agency or other body which processes personal data on behalf of the controller;

**'Recipient'** means a natural or legal person, public authority, agency or another body, to which the personal data are disclosed, whether a third party or not. However, public authorities which may receive personal data in the framework of a particular inquiry in accordance with Union or Member State law shall not be regarded as recipients; the processing of those data by those public authorities shall be in compliance with the applicable data protection rules according to the purposes of the processing;

**'Third party'** means a natural or legal person, public authority, agency or body other than the data subject, controller, processor and persons who, under the direct authority of the controller or processor, are authorised to process personal data;

**'Consent'** of the data subject means any freely given, specific, informed and unambiguous indication of the data subject's wishes by which he or she, by a statement or by a clear affirmative action, signifies agreement to the processing of personal data relating to him or her;

**'Personal data breach'** means a breach of security leading to the accidental or unlawful destruction, loss, alteration, unauthorised disclosure of, or access to, personal data transmitted, stored or otherwise processed;

**'Genetic data'** means personal data relating to the inherited or acquired genetic characteristics of a natural person which give unique information about the physiology or the health of that natural person and which result, in particular, from an analysis of a biological sample from the natural person in question;

**'Biometric data'** means personal data resulting from specific technical processing relating to the physical, physiological or behavioural characteristics of a natural person, which allow or confirm the unique identification of that natural person, such as facial images or dactyloscopic data;

**'Data concerning health'** means personal data related to the physical or mental health of a natural person, including the provision of health care services, which reveal information about his or her health status;

**'Enterprise'** means a natural or legal person engaged in an economic activity, irrespective of its legal form, including partnerships or associations regularly engaged in an economic activity;

**'Group of undertakings'** means a controlling undertaking and its controlled undertakings;

**'Supervisory authority'** means an independent public authority which is established by a Member State pursuant to Article 51.

## **E. PRINCIPLES OF DATA PROCESSING**

**Principles to be followed during the processing of personal data are as follows:**

1. Personal data shall be:

(a) processed lawfully, fairly and in a transparent manner in relation to the data subject (**'lawfulness, fairness and transparency'**);

(b) collected for specified, explicit and legitimate purposes and not further processed in a manner that is incompatible with those purposes; further processing for archiving purposes in the public interest, scientific or historical research purposes or statistical purposes shall, in accordance with Article 89(1), not be considered to be incompatible with the initial purposes (**'purpose limitation'**);

(c) adequate, relevant and limited to what is necessary in relation to the purposes for which they are processed (**'data minimisation'**);

(d) accurate and, where necessary, kept up to date; every reasonable step must be taken to ensure that personal data that are inaccurate, having regard to the purposes for which they are processed, are erased or rectified without delay (**'accuracy'**);

(e) kept in a form which permits identification of data subjects for no longer than is necessary for the purposes for which the personal data are processed; personal data may be stored for longer periods insofar as the personal data will be processed solely for archiving purposes in the public interest, scientific or historical research purposes or statistical purposes in accordance with Article 89(1) subject to implementation of the appropriate technical and organisational measures required by this Regulation in order to safeguard the rights and freedoms of the data subject (**'storage limitation'**);

(f) processed in a manner that ensures appropriate security of the personal data, including protection against unauthorised or unlawful processing and against accidental loss, destruction or damage, using appropriate technical or organisational measures (**'integrity and confidentiality'**).

The controller shall be responsible for, and be able to demonstrate compliance with, paragraph 1 (**'accountability'**).

## **F. WE PROTECT YOUR PERSONAL DATA THIS WAY**

Taking into account the state of the art, the costs of implementation and the nature, scope, context and purposes of processing as well as the risk of varying likelihood and severity for the rights and freedoms of natural persons, the controller and the processor shall implement appropriate technical and organisational measures to ensure a level of security appropriate to the risk, including inter alia as appropriate:

(a) the pseudonymisation and encryption of personal data;

(b) the ability to ensure the ongoing confidentiality, integrity, availability and resilience of processing systems and services;

(c) the ability to restore the availability and access to personal data in a timely manner in the event of a physical or technical incident;

(d) a process for regularly testing, assessing and evaluating the effectiveness of technical and organisational measures for ensuring the security of the processing.

## SECURITY OF PAPER BASED DATA PROCESSING

Medical Cart Company Kft applies the following security measures to protect paper based data processing:

- a.) personal data can be seen and accessed only by authorized persons, no one else is able to see or access them
- b.) paper based documents belonging to active customer relationships are accessible only by those who perform work on those files
- c.) employees and other persons participating in data processing may leave the office room or office building only if they securely place data carrier and documents or close the office room/office building
- d.) after finishing the work, documents will be stored in a locked storage place

## SECURITY OF DIGITIZED DATA

Medical cart Company make the following security steps to protect personal data stored on a comuter or network (server):

- a.) Computers are owned by M.C.C. Kft or M.C.C. Kft possesses similar rights regarding such equipments
- b.) Personal data on computers are accessible only by valid, personal user name and password, which are changed on a regular basis
- c.) Antivirus protection has been applied
- d.) Medical Cart Company Kf prevents unauthorized access to personal data stored electronically
